WORKSHOP: After the meeting, anyone interested is invited to participate in a WORKSHOP to study the naming and classification of the shell species in the EXHIBIT. Members are urged to bring their own specimens of:

(a) PLEUROTOMARIACEA. Families:
PLEUROTOMARIA (slit-shells);
SCISSUREILIDAE (tiny slit-shells);
HALIOTIDAE (abalones);
FISSURELLIDAE (Key-hole limpets).

(b) VENERACEA. Families:
VENERIDAE (Venus clams);
PETRICOLIDAE (Rock-boring venus clams);
COOPERELLIDAE (small mud-boring venerids).
