SATURDAY BOAT TRIP TO PORTSMOUTH ISLAND

As noted in the last Newsletter, we are definitely planning for a trip from Ocracoke, across the Ocracoke Inlet, to the Portsmouth end of the Cape Lookout National Seashore. The only deterrent would be that the Goddess of Weather would not smile on us and causes the water in the Inlet to be too rough to make the crossing. But, we won't even allow ourselves (being May) to think of that possibility. You should plan to go just to experience the area and what remains of "the Village", all now owned by the US National Park Service.

Established in 1753, Portsmouth grew to be the largest settlement on the Outer Banks by 1770 and by 1860 reached an all-time high of 685 residents. From there it was "downhill" Civil War economic and political interferences, later storms, shoaling of the Inlet, pestilences, etc. By 1956 the population was down to 17 and in 1971 the last 2 residents moved to the "mainland". While there are still a few buildings standing (the Methodist Church and one of the Government-owned residences are open to the public), it is truly a "ghost town".

But, if you do join the trip (and we hope that you do), you must be made well aware of a few drawbacks. There are mosquitoes, the weather might turn to windy rain, public facilities are almost non-existent and there is very little shelter from the sun. Bring insect repellent, adequate clothing, a hat and sturdy walking shoes. Swimming is discouraged. contd....

The round-trip cost will be just \$15 each and we ask that everyone planning to make the trip send this amount to the President by May 15th. But, be assured that if you cannot go or if the trip must be cancelled, you will receive a full refund.
